This series provides participants with training in a peer cohort environment that will prepare them for the Certified Climate Change Professional® (CC-P®) credential exams by leveraging a combination of video homework, live training and interactive exercises/discussions.

Participants will learn from experts and practitioners about the implications of climate change, and related opportunities, for Pennsylvania state agencies, infrastructure, residents and businesses. The curriculum has been designed to benefit professionals across a broad range of environmental program and policy roles and will incorporate regionally oriented case studies and scenarios for Pennsylvania and the mid-Atlantic United States.
